



#### **REASONS FOR CLOSED CASES**



#### Multi-System Youth (MSY) Funding

\$73,895 for 3 youth:

- to ensure a youth's successful return home from residential care
- to pay for a youth's placement in residential care
- to prevent a youth from being placed out of home
